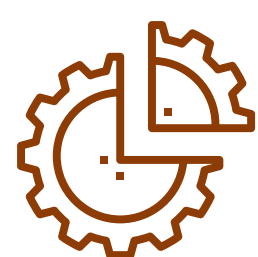


For design and delivery of VET

Provide a tool to VET Providers to assess the relevance of skills and qualifications they provide, in comparison to the ones requested by employers and VET authorities

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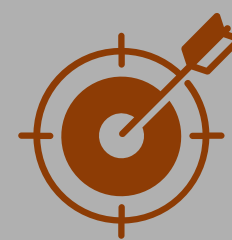
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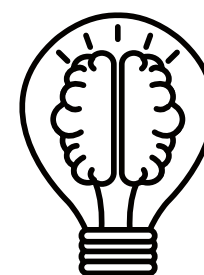
