## Frequently asked questions

**Question:** Do I get paid for participating in the Work for Ukrainians programme at Folkuniversitetet?

**Answer:** No, no extra payment is provided.

Question: Can I take part in the programme remotely?

**Answer:** No, the programme is only available at the places on the list.

Question: Is the Work for Ukrainians programme available in the Northern Sweden?

Answer: No, it isn't.

Question: How can I register when I need a personal identity number?

Answer: Go to the page in English, where no personal identity number is needed. Click on "Use the

English booking form".

Question: Do participants with children get help with a place at preschool/school during the

programme?

**Answer:** Children have the right to childcare, preschool/school, whether you participate in the

programme or not.

**Question:** Can I register if I don't have a coordination number, i.e. if I'm undocumented? **Answer:** Yes, but you must have proof that you're covered by the Mass Refugee Directive and a residence permit. You need to be able to show your UT card.

**Question:** Can I get help with my registration without knowing English or Swedish? **Answer:** Yes, we have Ukrainian and/or Russian-speaking staff who can help you.

**Question:** Is a UT card enough to prove that I'm here under the Mass Refugee Directive? **Answer:** Please see the example below. It should say: "Tillfälligt skydd direktiv 2001/55/EG"
