# What is IELTS?

**IELTS is an English test that assesses your listening, reading, writing and speaking skills.**

It helps you develop the kind of English you need in everyday life, whether you are at college, at work or talking to friends.

**There are two test types:**

### **IELTS Academic**

is for higher education or professional training.

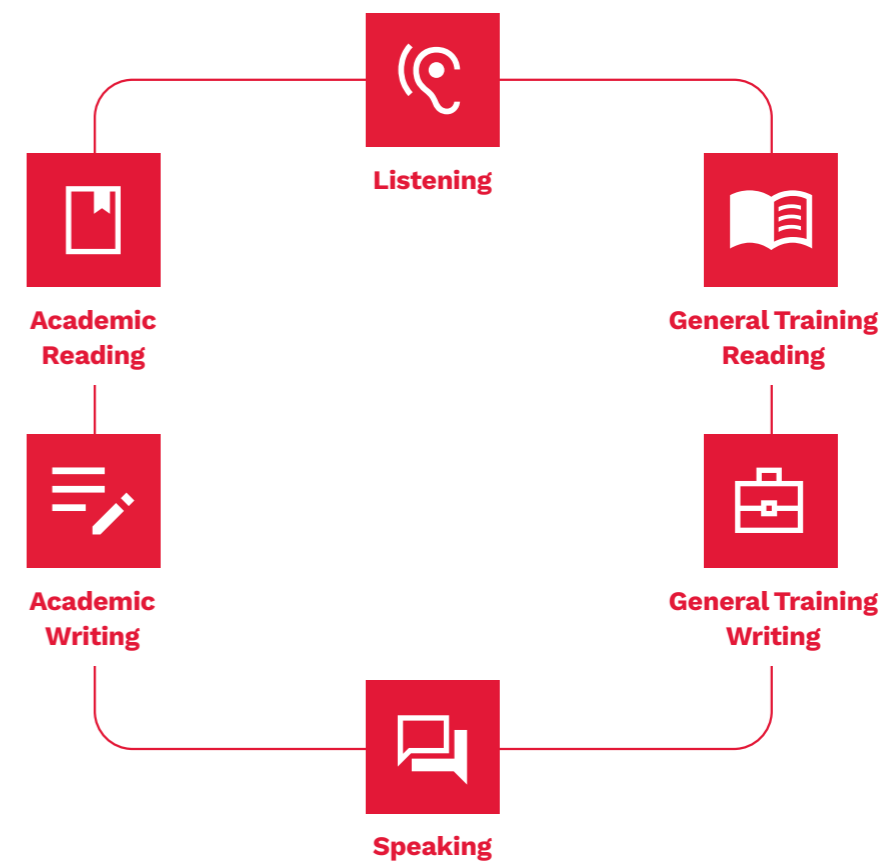
### **IELTS General Training**

is for secondary education, migration, work or training.

Whichever test you take, you'll get a score from 1 to 9 for each section – Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking.

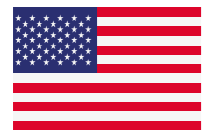
### United Kingdom

# How to book IELTS

Wherever your next move takes you, make the smart choice and choose IELTS from the British Council.

## Book online

Booking your IELTS test is quick, simple, and secure, and the process is the same for all IELTS tests. Visit our IELTS registration page and follow these steps:

### 1. Choose your test

Select IELTS Academic, IELTS General Training or IELTS for UKVI

### 2. Choose your test mode

Select IELTS on computer or IELTS Online (if available)

### 3. Select your country and city, then choose a date from the calendar

### 4. Book test

Enter your email to create your profile, then follow the prompts to book



### Before you book your test, make sure you have to hand:

- A photo or scan of your photo ID document (passport or national identity card). Your ID must be valid at the time of booking and on the test day
- Written consent from a parent/guardian if you are under 18
- A valid payment method

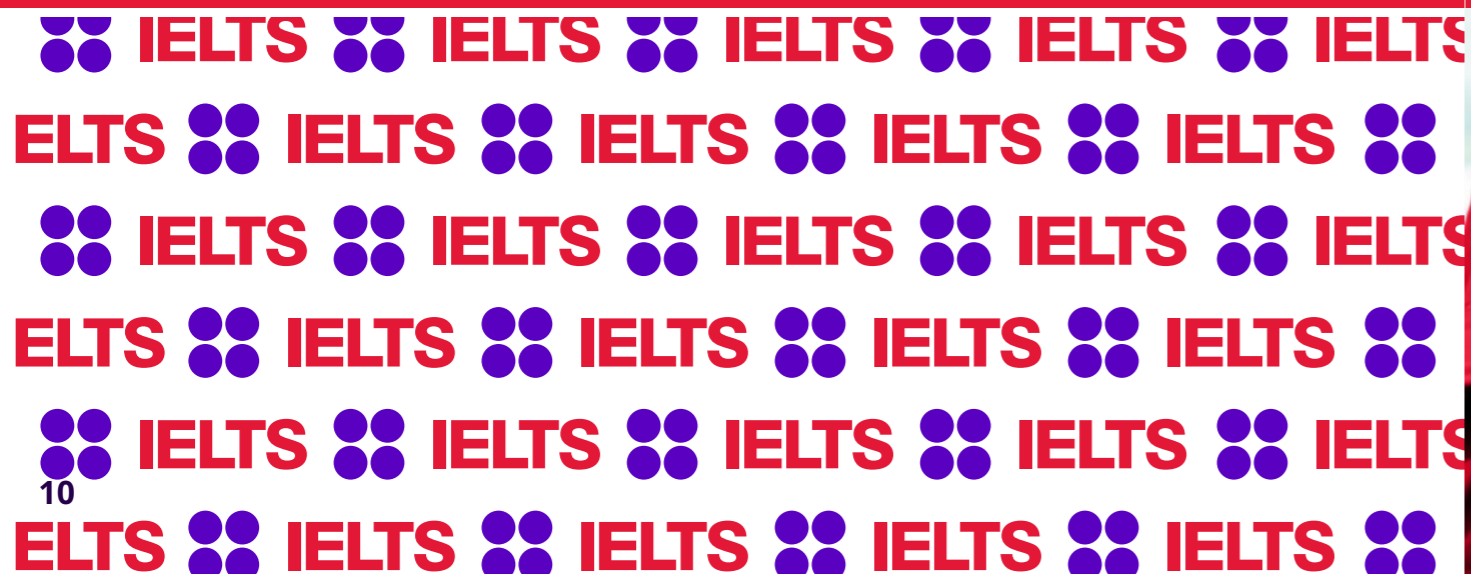
After booking, you'll receive a confirmation email with your IELTS Reference Number, which you'll need to manage your test booking and your test details.

# If you are going to the UK

If you're planning to move to the UK to live, work or study, you'll need to take an approved secure English language test for your visa.

We provide the following tests, approved by UKVI for visa applications to the UK:

- IELTS for UKVI (Academic or General Training)
- IELTS for UKVI Life Skills A1
- IELTS for UKVI Life Skills A2
- IELTS for UKVI Life Skills B1

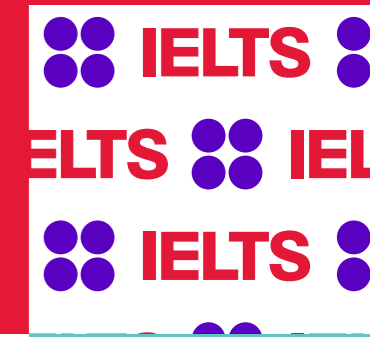


# IELTS for UKVI tests

## IELTS for UKVI

IELTS for UKVI is a government-approved English language test that can be used in support of a UK Visa and Immigration application.

## IELTS for UKVI Life Skill

To live in the UK, you'll need to take an IELTS for UKVI Life Skills test, which assesses your English speaking and listening skills.

There are three versions available:

- IELTS for UKVI Life Skills A1
- IELTS for UKVI Life Skills A2
- IELTS for UKVI Life Skills B1

The tests focus on topics like family, work, housing and daily life in the UK, and are fully approved by UK Visas and Immigration (UKVI).

You can use your results in your UK visa, settlement or citizenship application. The test that you need to take will depend on which visa you are applying for.

The tests assess your English skills at levels A1, A2, or B1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

Level	Skills assessed	Common visa types
Life Skills A1	Speaking and Listening	Basic family visas, some settlement applications
Life Skills A2	Speaking and Listening	Some settlement applications
Life Skills B1	Speaking and Listening	British citizenship, some settlement routes

# Your test, your way

You can choose to take your IELTS test in a test centre, or online.

## **IELTS in a test centre**

Take IELTS on computer in one of our test centres for your Academic or General Training Test. The speaking section is done face-to-face with a qualified IELTS Examiner, either in centre or via a video call.

## **IELTS Online**

IELTS Online has the same test content as IELTS on computer taken in an IELTS test centre, but you can take it from the comfort of our own home or private space. The speaking section is done via a video call.

## **More choice, same trusted test**

Whether you choose to take your test in a test centre or at home, the test content and scoring system is the same. All test formats also have the same Report Form and security measures that make IELTS the world's most trusted English language test.
