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The BuSYouth Expert Workshop in Tenerife

The workshop

On September 19-20, 2024, Tenerife hosted an expert workshop organized by DISRUPTIA, bringing together the partnership to finalize the development of the training material for the Creative Hive OER. The workshop served as a key milestone in assessing the status of the online networking space and forum, ensuring its functionality aligns with the project's objectives. Participants engaged in a detailed presentation of the e-platform and its training modules, followed by discussions on visual elements, usability, and overall functionality to enhance the e-learning experience. Additionally, the status of the Online Assessment Tool and translation efforts led by DISRUPTIA was reviewed to ensure accessibility across different languages. Another crucial aspect of the workshop was defining the structure for the validation procedure, which included identifying how various learning elements would be assessed based on the project's key performance indicators (KPIs). The discussion also focused on testing different learning methods, both synchronous and asynchronous, to ensure they cater to diverse learning needs. Through hands-on evaluation, structured feedback, and strategic planning, the workshop significantly contributed to refining the Creative Hive OER platform, strengthening its impact on creative and educational communities.



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Strategic Planning and Implementation of the Piloting Tests

A key outcome of the workshop in Tenerife was the strategic planning of the piloting tests, which will play a crucial role in assessing the effectiveness and usability of the Creative Hive OER training materials. The partnership established a clear timeline for the launch of piloting phases across all participating countries, ensuring a structured and comparative evaluation process. These tests will allow participants to engage with both synchronous and asynchronous learning methods, providing valuable insights into their accessibility, engagement levels, and overall learning impact.

Additionally, the partnership defined the criteria for evaluating the different training modules based on the project's key performance indicators (KPIs), ensuring that the content meets quality standards and aligns with the needs of target users. The piloting phase will also assess the functionality of the e-platform, the effectiveness of the online networking space and forum, and the usability of the online assessment tool, ensuring a seamless and user-friendly experience. By gathering structured feedback from test users, the partnership aims to refine and optimize the platform before its full implementation, reinforcing the Creative Hive OER's role as a dynamic and inclusive learning resource.
