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AIM & OBJECTIVES

The "Women Empowerment through (WEntre) project aims to Entrepreneurship" capacities of enhance the Vocational Education and Training (VET) providers in Egypt through developing and delivering educational programs focused on key compeences in entrepreneurship. This initiative is designed to empower women to combat unemployment inequality through and gender skill development aligned with the European Reference Framework (ERF) and the European Competence Entrepreneurship Framework (ENTRECOMP), fostering employability and social inclusion



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OBJECTIVES

- Develop cooperation between VET providers and entrepreneurial organizations, focusing on the development and validation of enhanced digital competences
- Implement the entire cycle of the VET educational program, from design to evaluation and validation
- Design and develop VET curricula and materials for new digital skills related to entrepreneurship, aligned with EQF Level 5.
- Enhance the capacities of VET providers in Egypt in designing curricula and materials aligned with EQF and European Quality Assurance in Vocational Education and training (EQAVET) standards
- Create an assessment tool for the developed curriculum to validate non-formal learming
- Develop and validate the learners' competences.
- Empower VET providers in Egypt through capacity building activities such as joint workshops and training of master trainers.
- Promote these capacity-building results to other VET providers within and outside the project consortium

MAIN RESULTS

- Enhanced Digital Competences: VET providers and entrepreneurship organizations will have improved capacities in developing and validating digital competences.
- **Developed VET Curriculum:** A comprehensive VET curriculum and materials for digital skills in entrepreneurship, aligned with EQF Level 5, will be created.
- **Capacity Building:** VET providers in third countries will be empowered through capacity-building activities, including joint workshops and training of master trainers.
- **Assessment Tool:** An assessment tool for validating the developed curriculum and non-formal learning will be developed.
- **Promoted Best Practices**: Best praceices, skills gaps, and needs in the women entrepreneurship sector will be showcased through national reports.
- **Participatory Workshops:** Workshops will foster idea exchange, networking, and capacity building among partners.
- Video Testimonials: A video featuring partner workshops, training events, and pilot trainings will be produced, showcasing testimonials from partners, learners, and trainers.
- WEntre Network: The project will establish a network for continuous engagement, collaboration, and dissemination of results among VET providers and stakeholders.
